1 SLOVENIA *Hannah Johnson*
Today we plan to host a prayer walk in Ptuj. We have invited others from around Slovenia to join us as we pray for our city.

8 CROATIA *Steve & Jenny Meeker*
Leadership Lab International *Transform* starts today through August 13. Pray that God will use the training to equip and empower those attending this summer to serve in Jesus' Great Commission around the world.

2 EAST ASIA
Pray for health for the team leader in East Asia. Her leadership requires much travel; she asks prayer for clarity of thought and peace of heart. There is great transition happening in her area and she needs her heart protected in the midst of so many demands and requests.

9 EAST ASIA
A youth mission camp runs June 6-10 in Hong Kong. SEND will host a booth today. Ask the Lord to use this conference to encourage young believers to join in global outreach and to bring the right people to SEND's booth to connect with SEND workers.

3 SEND NORTH
Today concludes a week-long basketball session at Tanalian Bible Camp, Port Alsworth, AK, the largest fly-in Bible camp. Pray for Brett & Christy Zimmerman, pilot and activity coordinator. Pray for campers' safe return home, not just with better skills, but with determination to follow Christ and learn from his Word.

10 MUSLIM EUROPE
Pray for a team of eight from a supporting church in Cleveland that will lead an English camp June 10-16. Pray for good connections with students and significant conversations.

4 EAST ASIA
Praise God for the visit of the SE Asia team in May and the training workshop they offered in Hong Kong. Ask the Lord to help the participants use the materials to serve Muslims. Pray also that more people will be interested in serving among Muslims through SEND.

11 EAST ASIA
Pray for a SEND family working between two locations. Pray for fast learning of language and adaptation to new environments. Praise the Lord that both their daughters were accepted by a good school for this next year.

5 THAILAND
Pray for the Isaan Khorat start-up team as they strategize and plan this month to build a foundation for a future ministry thrust throughout the province. Pray also for the Lord of the Harvest to send more workers.

12 CROATIA
The Bekins move from Zagreb to Bjelovar where they are trusting the Lord to raise up a church; there are no Protestant churches in this city of 40,000. They will begin in partnership with Koprivnica Baptist Church. Their ministry partner, Daniel Herceg, will move to Bjelovar this summer.

6 JAPAN *Jim & Angela May*
Praise the Lord that we could start our monthly Junior and Senior High Worship & Bible Hour. Pray for Ana Aquino who is leading this, for good attendance, for the growth of our leaders, and for God to use this time to strengthen and grow the faith of these young people.

13 SPAIN *John & April McDuffee*
El Ensanche de Vallecas — Pray for us as we seek to implement creative and natural avenues to connect with people during the summer months when we don't hold English language classes. Pray for open hearts as we engage people in gospel-centered conversations.
