

EURASIA SEND PRAYER GUIDE

Daily requests for March 2019 from our workers in Russia, Central Asia and Ukraine

Friday, March 1 — Pray today for 10% of the Muslims of the world to come to Christ in the next 10 years. Over 180 missions and ministry outreaches have banded together to corporately cover every day of the year with prayer for Muslim peoples.

Saturday, March 2 — SEND's US Office property is up for sale. Ask the Lord to guide the US Office leadership as they seek God's direction for the next location and for quietness of heart and mind for the office staff in the midst of transition.

Sunday, March 3 — Pray for salvation for people all across Eurasia.

Monday, March 4 — **Jay Francis** is facilitating a Kairos missions education course in English in Kyiv, Ukraine. Pray that the students will be greatly impacted by the material presented.

Tuesday, March 5 — Praise the Lord for 16 years of fruitful ministry for **Greg and Patti Wilton** in Ukraine! Ask the Lord to guide them as they retire from SEND and seek to serve the Lord in North America.

Wednesday, March 6 — Thomas and Kaitlin R. and May N. want to serve the Lord in Russia for one year starting this summer. Many details need to be figured out. Ask God to provide a way in His perfect timing.

Thursday, March 7 — Ask God to give Eurasia leadership wisdom and discernment in decisions, counsel and the varied situations they face.

Friday, March 8 — Today is International Women's Day, a major holiday in Eurasia. Praise the Lord for our women who have committed to serve the Lord in Russia, Ukraine and Central Asia!

Saturday, March 9 — Pray that Ukrainian believers will grow in their desire to serve internationally and to reach out to the tens of thousands of people from other nations who live in Ukraine.

Sunday, March 10 — Ask the Lord to give Russia Area Director **Dave B.** and his wife, **Martina**, wisdom as he oversees the team's ministries.

Monday, March 11 — Ukraine alumni Don and Esther Parsons and their daughter Joy are visiting Ukraine, March 11-25. Ask the Lord to give them a fruitful time of engaging with the Ukraine team and participating in a missions conference in Odessa, Ukraine.

Tuesday, March 12 — Kim Burkett (L'viv, Ukraine) is in Austria to participate in the training course Developing a Discerning Heart. Pray that the material will not only influence her personally but also will affect the lives of those she serves in Ukraine.

Wednesday, March 13 — Pray that our Eurasia workers will walk in the strength and joy of the Lord, especially in the midst of hard situations.

Thursday, March 14 — Central Asia team leader **MK** and his family are on home service through May. Pray for them as they are doing a lot of traveling this month.

Friday, March 15 — One of our longtime missionary couples will visit our newest team, Team Unity in U City, Russia, April-June. Ask God to provide housing and necessary documentation and to allow them to be a blessing and encouragement.

Saturday, March 16 — The **Z family** is ministering to families in the Y village who have significant physical, financial and documentation needs. Pray that they will receive answers in such a way that all will see the marvelous deeds of the Lord.

Sunday, March 17 — Light of Love English Club (Ulan-Ude) is working through the Bible. Pray that many will be saved and grow in the knowledge of Jesus Christ.

Monday, March 18 — Ask the Lord to give our Eurasia MKs a contagious passion for the Word of God.

Tuesday, March 19 — Acting International Director Barry Rempel, and his wife, Ruth, will be in Ukraine, March 19-26. Pray that their time visiting with the Ukraine team and participating in a missions conference will be fruitful.

Wednesday, March 20 — Pray for the English clubs in Kirsanov and Tambov, Russia, which are primarily attended by unbelievers. Pray that God will give the club leaders opportunities to share the love and hope of the gospel.

Thursday, March 21 — Pray that the churches in Russia and Ukraine will have unity despite ongoing tensions between the two countries.

Friday, March 22 — **MG** (Central Asia) is working with young orphans who are facing education decisions. Ask God to give the young people courage and wisdom.

Saturday, March 23 — Many women in the Y village are in very difficult marriages. Pray that they will come to know God and find their hope in Him.

Sunday, March 24 — Praise the Lord for **HH** who is working alongside **JO** in the International Student Ministry in Kyiv! Pray that God will work in H's life and show her all He has for her while she is in Ukraine.

Monday, March 25 — Eurasia Regional Director Carl Kresge will be in Russia March 26-April 13. Ask the Lord to allow him to be an encouragement to team members, the leadership team and national believers.

Tuesday, March 26 — Pray for **Jay Francis** as he teaches on eschatology at Ivano-Frankivsk Bible College in Ukraine.

Wednesday, March 27 — Ukraine's presidential election will take place March 31. Pray that a person will be elected who will lead the country in a way that will cause the gospel to flourish.

Thursday, March 28 — Eurasia has several needs for teachers to come alongside homeschool families. Ask God to provide teachers with a heart to engage the unreached and assist in educating our children.

Daily requests for April 2019 from our workers in Russia, Central Asia and Ukraine

Monday, April 1 — Pray for God's wisdom and discernment for **Dave Benzel** as he teaches a theology course at Kyiv Theological Seminary, April 1-5.

Tuesday, April 2 — Ask God to bring spiritual revival to the people of Central Asia.

Wednesday, April 3 — Lori Kresge, Sherri Divozzo and Lynn Karidis are traveling to Russia to facilitate a Soul Care Retreat, April 7-11. Ask God to protect these women as they travel and make numerous flight connections.

Thursday, April 4 — Eurasia Regional Director Carl Kresge and Russia Area Director **Dave B.** have a busy travel schedule as they visit each of our ministry teams. Pray that God will guide their travels and their discussions over the next 10 days.

Friday, April 5 — 10/10 Prayer Initiative: Ask the Lord to bring 10% of the world's Muslims to Jesus in the next 10 years.

Saturday, April 6 — Pray that the Y people will move from opposing Christianity to loving Jesus and living for His glory.

Sunday, April 7 — The women on the Russia team are participating in a five-day Soul Care Retreat. Pray that this will be a precious time of learning and growing in their relationship with Jesus and with one another. Pray for strength, wisdom and stamina for SEND Spiritual Care Coordinator Lynn Karidis as she guides the women through the retreat.

Monday, April 8 — **Leif G.** (Ulan-Ude) is planning a hiking trip with unbelievers. Ask the Lord to prepare the hearts of those who will join the trip.

Tuesday, April 9 — Ask God to give Eurasia Regional Director Carl Kresge and his wife, Lori, vision and wisdom as he leads and encourages Eurasia Area Directors **Dave Benzel** (Ukraine) and **Dave B.** (Russia) and Team Leader **MK** (Central Asia).

Wednesday, April 10 — Ask the Lord to give Ukraine Area Director **Dave Benzel** and his wife, **Sharon**, wisdom as he oversees the team's ministries.

Thursday, April 11 — There are two potential participants for the Engage Russia internship program this summer. Ask the Lord to give **Jenni M.** (Tambov, Russia) wisdom as she works out the details with these individuals.

Friday, April 12 — Team members in Ulan-Ude are hosting an English language Bible study. Half of those who attend are unbelievers. Pray that these precious people will come to know Jesus as Savior as they study the book of James together.

Saturday, April 13 — Ask the Lord to guide our Eurasia parents as they seek His wisdom in raising their children cross culturally.

Sunday, April 14 — **Herb and Kim Burkett** (L'viv) are in the States for a short home service. Ask the Lord to provide rest, refreshment, and good connections with family, friends and supporters.

Monday, April 15 — Eurasia MKs are making important decisions about college. Ask God to give wisdom and discernment as college visits are made, and ask Him to provide generous scholarships and grants.

Tuesday, April 16 — Basement construction at Transformation Christian Center in Russia is in process. The project will allow for recreational activity space and a 100-seat auditorium. Pray that it will be done before summer ministries begin.

Wednesday, April 17 — Ask the Lord to provide Spirit-filled, like-minded partners for the work in Central Asia.

Thursday, April 18 — Praise the Lord for the spiritual growth in the young man **Rick K.** (Tambov) has been discipling. Ask the Lord to give this young man the passion and conviction to keep sharing his faith with friends, family and colleagues.

Friday, April 19 — Praise the Lord for several orphan graduates in Central Asia who are considering baptism! Ask the Lord to move in the hearts and minds of other orphan graduates as they witness the testimony and changed lives of their peers.

Saturday, April 20 — Tomorrow is Easter in Eurasia. Ask the Lord of the Harvest to speak into the lives of those who will hear the gospel message. Pray that many will come to know Christ.

Sunday, April 21 — Pray for strong and healthy friendships for our single missionaries.

Monday, April 22 — Eurasia college MKs are preparing for final exams. Pray for good time management, clear minds, healthy bodies, and an understanding of the material they have learned.

Tuesday, April 23 — Pray for our Eurasia workers who serve as teachers. Ask God to give them wisdom and creativity as they work with students of all ages.

Wednesday, April 24 — The current leader of the International Student Ministry in Kyiv will be on home service this coming fall. Ask the Lord to provide the person of His choosing to fill the leadership role.

Thursday, April 25 — Pray for our Eurasia women as they walk with the Lord and trust Him for guidance in their personal lives and ministries.

Friday, April 26 — Praise the Lord for the HiBA groups in Russia that are meeting weekly to disciple young people! Pray that the relationship between TELA and the Russian Baptist Union will further develop this ministry into a useful resource for youth workers in local churches.

Saturday, April 27 — Several Eurasia workers are waiting for temporary residency permits. The process is long and often frustrating. Ask the Lord to give them patience and a peace that passes all understanding.

Sunday, April 28 — Ask the Lord to raise up workers to serve Him in Russia, Ukraine and Central Asia.
